NEW YORK STATE FAIR CAMPING POLICY

Welcome to the New York State Fair! Our Camping Policy has been developed for the protection of our campers and campsites. If you have any questions during your stay, please contact the Security Office at 315-728-4399.

Locations

Camping is only allowed in the designated areas. See reverse side map for approved locations.

Registration

All campers must register with the Security Department upon arrival.

Prohibited dumping of gray and black water

It is a violation of the New York State Sanitary Code to dump waste, toilet and/or kitchen water on the ground. This rule is <u>strictly enforced</u>, and violators may have their camping permit revoked. Free dumping stations are located on the grounds near Gates 9 and 10 for emptying holding tanks.

Site Rules

RV vehicles, tow vehicles, and any other items <u>must fit within</u> the assigned RV site and not impose upon neighboring sites or fire lanes in any direction. RVs, slide-outs, pop-ups, awnings, grills, furniture, etc. must not encroach on the assigned site of another guest. State Fair management are the sole arbiters of whether a vehicle extends beyond the site. Any vehicle causing a disturbance to neighboring sites, roadways, fire lanes, etc. may be relocated or removed from the property. Tent Camping is not allowed on the Fairgrounds.

Recreational fires

Recreational fires are allowed but must be contained in a fire pit, ring or fireplace that is no more than 3 feet round and 2 feet high. Fires cannot be directly next to a camper or under an awning or shelter. A portable fire extinguisher or other approved on-site fire-extinguishing equipment, such as dirt, sand, water barrel, garden hose or water truck, <u>must be available</u> for immediate utilization. State Fair Security will patrol the camping areas and has the authority to direct campers to extinguish fires if deemed too large or unsafe. Failure to comply with Fair Security (or the Solvay Fire Department) directive will result in revocation of a camping permit.

Conduct

The close configuration of RV lots requires that our guests behave as good neighbors and conduct themselves in a manner that provides for the comfort and enjoyment of all. Please be considerate and respectful:

- Keep noise from electronics and vehicles to a minimum. Noise should not emit beyond your immediate campsite and disturb your neighbors.
- All areas must be kept free of trash. All trash must be placed in plastic trash bags. Trash receptacles and dumpsters will be provided.
